

## WÖSS & PARTNERS HELPS REDUCE PIPE ANTI-DUMPING DUTY

Wöss & Partners, SC has helped Berg Steel Pipe Corporation obtain a reduction of an anti-dumping duty applied on imports to Mexico of carbon steel pipe for oil and gas pipelines from the US.

The sunset review ruled on 18 November that the anti-dumping duty applicable to Berg Steel would be reduced to 4.04 per cent from 25.43 per cent, with the existing duty remaining for all other US exporters.

According to the head of Wöss & Partners' trade practice, Herfried Wöss, the firm worked intensively on the case, and is pleased with the result.

Wöss & Partners worked with Berg Steel's parent company Europepipe on an anti-dumping case in 2007, when the firm obtained the total elimination of a 30.6 per cent anti-dumping duty against the German pipe manufacturer.

The firm expects to work on the expiry of the long-standing anti-dumping duties against China on 11 December.
